


450 GAME-CHANGERS

Wine and adventure don't normally go together, but that's the alluring combination you'll find at this lush South American mega-estate that opened in December 2013. Hop on a horse and take to the pampas with a gaucho concierge, or choose between helping punch down a fermenting tank of grapes or planting vines, depending on the season. Experience an open-air barbecue or head to the resort's signature restaurant, Siete Fuegos, where Francis Mallmann -Argentina's most famous chef — shows off his mastery of both fire and French technique with dishes such as a rib-eye steak that's slow grilled for nine hours. Of course, if your personal idea of adventure is dozing in a cabaña by the glittering infinity pool surrounded by the grandeur of the Andes, está bien.
